




Installation




Use forklift or pallet jack to move and set cabinet in place. Cabinet must be locked while moving. If a base is supplied, remove front cover for access.






Fixed cabinets must be anchored to the floor. Install (2) 3/8 anchors into the floor using the layout in Fig.1. After anchors are installed, slide cabinet into the anchors and secure nut and washer to the cabinet with 9/16" deep socket. If you do not have a base, lower cabinet into place and secure cabinet to the anchor with 9/16" deep socket.





Installation



Remove drawers as need for access to secure concrete anchor to cabinet base. Note, unit must be in the unlocked position. To remove drawer, extend drawer to full extension. Pull gray lock out on middle slide member, see Fig. 2. Pull drawer out and lift over drawer slide stop as needed to remove. To remove more than one drawer, reach in and push the lock pawl in on the locking mechanism. This may require us of a rod to reach the unit, See Fig. 3 and Fig. 4. To install drawer, reverse removal step. Note when installing drawers, there is no need to reset the locking mechanism or alter the position of the pawls.









Cabinet Stacking

Remove drawers, see step 3. Punch out the knockouts on the top and bottom of the cabinet using a punch and hammer, See Fig. 7. Align cabinets so that the front and top are flush. Use hardware shown in Fig. 6. Install all drawers.






Proper Use



Do not try to open more than one drawer at a time. Your cabinet includes an anti tip locking device that only allows one drawer to open at a time. Forcing more than one drawer at a time may result in damage.






How to Load

STEP 1.

- Start by loading the bottom drawer first.
- Load the drawer from the back to the front of the drawer.

STEP 2.

- Load the second lowest drawer in the same manner as the first.
- Repeat until drawers are filled.



Proper Care

- Periodically clean the drawer fronts, drawer trim, and other surfaces with a mild detergent and water.
- Auto wax preserves the storage unit's finish and protects against scratches. Apply the wax as you would on a car.

Safety Information

- Secure the product before use.
- Do not tow the product with power equipment.
- Do not alter this product in any manner. Doing so will void the warranty.
- When locking unit, make sure all drawers or doors are in the fully closed position in order for the locking system to work properly.



Do not attach or mount this product to a vehicle. This may cause personal injury or product damage. Mounting this product to a vehicle in any manner will void the warranty.
